Old Head Golf Links, Ireland

The Old Head Golf Links is one of the most remarkable development ever conceived in the history of golf: An Atlantic promontory that will never be rivaled in terms of drama and beauty. It rises hundreds of feet high above dramatic cliffs, surrounded by the ocean on all sides of the, and commanding the most spectacular views from every part.

Old Head Golf Links is built on a 220-acre diamond of land, jutting out over two miles into the Atlantic Ocean. The promontory is almost an island with numerous caves running beneath your feet as you play the course.

Machrihanish Golf Club, Scotland



The Machrihanish Golf Club is a classic Scottish links course situated in Machrihanish at the southern tip of the Mull of Kintyre. The main course, with views of the western seaboard including the Paps of Jura and Ireland, was ranked the #39 course outside of the United States by Golf Digest in 2005. In particular, the first hole is often rated as one of the best opening holes in the world. The golf club was founded in 1876 as the Kintyre Golf Club. The course had ten holes before the club officially existed, and was quickly expanded to 12. In 1879, Old Tom Morris was brought in to redesign and expand the course to the full 18 holes, including today's first hole. J.H. Taylor made some modifications in 1914, and in the 1940s Sir Guy Campbell brought the course to its current configuration.




Bro Hof Slott Golf Club, Sweden

The Stadium Course at Bro Hof Slott GC near Stockholm may just be the course that most golfers dream of playing. It has been voted Sweden's best golf course two years running. And recently voted one of Europe's finest golf courses. This very tough lakeside and parkland-type course is competition ready and will host the Nordea Scandinavian Masters in 2010 & 2011.

Bro Hof's surroundings are unbelievably beautiful and, for the first time in twenty years, a course has been built right by the water. Robert Trent Jones, who has been synonymous with the ultimate in golf design for over 30 years, has finally designed a course in Sweden. It is probable that no other course in the world has had such specified requirements.

Thracian Cliffs Golf Club, Bulgaria



Thracian Cliffs is located on the northern Black Sea Coast of Bulgaria. According to Gary Player, it is destined to become one of Europe's top resorts.

The project started in 2006 and is divided into stages; the first stage is almost complete and the last one will be finished in 2011. The 18-hole Gary Player Golf Course forms the core of the development that was designed prior to situating the real estate components within the resort.

This fact permitted Gary the optimum positioning of the eighteen holes directly along the cliffs on an undulating terrain without being compromised by the location of buildings.

Carefully selected locations of tees and greens on 164 hectares of wild, scenic Black Sea cliff terrain, spanning 4.5 kilometers along the coast, bestow a truly exhilarating golfing experience.

DESIGN



Costa Navarino Bay Golf, Greece

Opened in October 2011, the Bay Course offers an alternative set of challenges and choices in a quite different setting. Designed by leading American architect Robert Trent Jones Jr., it plays a little shorter than the Dunes Course at 5,760metres from the back tees. The par 71 course places a slightly greater emphasis on strategic play and positional golf.

The Seaside, Canyon, and Grove holes will provide striking contrasts that create a dramatic and memorable golf round. The course will play to a par of 71 from a variety of lengths designed to test the golfing skills of amateurs and pros alike. The imaginative layout offers panoramic seaside and mountain views, including several holes that play directly along the sea and two directly overlooking the historic bay of Navarino.
